Do not use excessive force.



The instruments tip is inserted into the sulcus towards the root in a most possible axial direction.

The tip is guided deeper along the root through gentle pressure and twisting movement in apical direction.



For optimal placement of the instrument, the tips are worked out more delicate.

Note: These X-Tools have been developed as an alternative for classic elevators. The instrument must not be used as a lever.


Furthermore the gentle removal of the teeth should be reached by axial luxation and cutting the scharpev's fibres.
